



Balfour Beatty Construction Northern is moving to Blythe Valley Park in Solihull.

The company is moving into a 4,305 sq ft office in Cornwall House on the park, which is developed and managed by Liberty Property Trust UK in partnership with Doughty Hanson & Co Real Estate.

The move from Birmingham is to offer an improved working environment for employees and better access to other parts of the country.

It will also mean Balfour Beatty Construction Northern is situated close to another Balfour Beatty company, Balfour Beatty Engineering Services, which already has a base at Blythe Valley Park.

Rob Lane, of Balfour Beatty Construction, said: “We have been looking at Blythe Valley for some time. It’s a great location, perfect for access to anywhere in the country.

“The park has a real air of quality about it that sets it apart from other business parks and this will be a great place from which to work and do business.

“Of course, it makes sense to be closer to another Balfour Beatty company but it was really the quality of the park and location that attracted us here.”

Kate Smith, of Liberty Property Trust, said Blythe Valley Park was the perfect fit for Balfour Beatty.

She said: “We are home to a range of major international engineering and construction firms and organisations from BAM to Arup and Scott Wilson as well as small and medium sized companies.

“We have seen a rise in enquiries for space here at Blythe Valley and we are very hopeful that this will be first of a series of new companies coming to the park.”
